

Privacy Policy

Introduction

This is Poynton Ear Care's (PEC) privacy notice. It ensures that any personal information that you give us, e.g., when you fill out a form or contact us, is kept confidentially to ensure your privacy is protected.

How we handle your data

PEC is committed to processing data in accordance with its responsibilities under the EU General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR).

This means that your personal data shall be:

- processed lawfully
- fairly and in a transparent manner in relation to individuals
- collected for specified, explicit and legitimate purposes and not processed in a manner that is incompatible with those purposes
- adequate, relevant and limited to what is necessary in relation to the purposes for which they are processed

How we process your data

If you decide to book an appointment, the information you provide on arrangement, including the consent and contra-indications form will be used to:

- determine if ear wax removal is suitable for you
- enable PEC to book you an appointment/home visit
- enable PEC to send you appointment reminders & service information

Who we may need to share your data with

In order to provide our services, we may need to pass data to other healthcare professionals including your GP but only with your express permission. Practices have robust data protection policies of their own. Your data will be managed in-keeping with their own Privacy Policies, which may be different from this one but will still be in accordance with the GDPR.

Your rights

PEC is committed to ensuring that your privacy is protected. Only the information that we collect about you lawfully in accordance with the GDPR.

We may change this policy from time to time by updating this document.

At all times this information is protected in a manner fully in-keeping with the GDPR.

You have the right at any time to request from PEC:

- What personal data are being processed
- The purposes for which the personal data are being processed
- Who, if anyone, the personal data are disclosed to
- The right to request the deletion of all data we hold about you
